# **Itinerary**


- Feb 22 Departure (20.45) from Schiphol Airport (Amsterdam, Netherlands; flight KL 4141) to Nairobi (Kenia).
- Feb 23 Arrival in Nairobi at 07.15. Various birds at the airport, e.g. Augur Buzzard *Buteo augur*, Departure at 08.35 (flight KL 4160). Arrival at Entebbe (Uganda) at 09.40. Picked up by Benson Bamutura (birdguide) and 'Emmy' (Emmanual; driver). Drive to Murchison Falls NP (MFNP) via Bugungu Wildlife Reserve. Overnight stay at Red Chilli (self-contained bandas).




Feb 24 Left at 07.00 for game drive North of the Nile. Many mammals, including African Elephant Loxodonta africana and Rothschildt's Giraffe Giraffa rothschildi. Best bird was probably Abyssinian Ground-Hornbill Bucorvus abyssinicus. During the afternoon we had a boat tour on the Nile to the Murchison Falls (14.00-17.30). Best bird was Rock Pratincole Glareola nuchalis. African Eagle Owl Bubo africanus seen during 'spot light tour'. Overnight stay at Red Chilli.



- Feb 25 During the morning bird watching along the road in Murchison Falls NP. Left at 14.30 for drive to Budongo Forest Reserve (BNP). Bird watching at BNP with a local guide (Raymond) to 18.00. Several good forest birds, including Ituri Batis *Batis ituriensis*. Overnight stay at Masindi.
- Feb 26 Left at 05.45 for drive to the 'Royal Mile' (BNP). Birdwatching from about 07.00 to 18.30 along the 'Royal Mile' and various trails in the forest (a.o. African Crowned Eagle *Stephanoaetus coronatus* and good views of Narina Trogon *Apaloderma narina*). Overnight stay at Masindi.



- Feb 27 Drive to Kibale National Park (KNP). Various stops during the day, including papyrus swamp. Overnight stay at the (new) Chimps Nest.
- Feb 28 Started bird watching from 07.00. Best bird was Shining-blue Kingfisher *Alcedo quadribrachys*. Drive (13.30) to headquarters of KNP. Birdwatching along main road. Birds included Mountain Wagtail *Motacilla clara* and Crowned Hornbill *Tockus alboterminatus*. Slept at Chimps Nest.
- Feb 29 Joined an organized chimp tracking (08.15 11.30). Stunning views of chimps at close range. Afternoon drive to Queen Elizabeth National Park (QENP). Birdwatching along the entrance road produced Temmincks' Courser *Cursorius temminckii* and Imperial Eagle *Aquila heliaca*. A walk around Mweya hostel was quite productive. Overnight stay at Mweya Hostel.



- Mar 1 Whole day of bird watching from the car (morning), a few hours near the hostel (early afternoon) and car (late afternoon and early evening). Many mammals, including Lions *Panthero leo*. Likely the best bird of the day was a Small Buttonquail *Turnix sylvatica*. Overnight stay at Mweya Hostel.
- Mar 2 Stunning views of a Leopard *Panthera pardus* in QENP. Drive to Ruhija, arrival at about 16.00 (elevation approx. 2350 m, part of Bwindi Impenetrable National Park; BINP). Afternoon birding near Ruhija. Slept in a rather cold tent.



- Mar 3 Walk (short trail) to Mubwindi Swamp (07.00-15.15), accompanied by an armed ranger. Afternoon birding near Ruhija. Again slept in a tent at the campsite (under construction).
- Mar 4 Morning drive to 'the 'Neck'. A walk produced various goodbirds, including Black Bee-eater *Merops gularis*. Arrival at about 14.00 in Bwindi. Since (15.30) we were not allowed to enter the park, we birded along the main road. Several species of Sunbirds. Overnight stay at the beautifully situated Community Bandas.



- Mar 5 Birdwatching in Bwindi from 07.00 13.00 and 15.00 17.30. Rainshowers in the afternoon. Birds tended to be very quiet and not or hardly responded to tape. Good views of Bar-tailed Trogon *Apaloderma vittatum*. Around 17.30, we managed to see two Mountain Gorilla's *Gorilla gorilla*. Again overnight stay at the Community Bandas.
- Mar 6 Left Bwindi at 06.30 for a long drive to Entebbe (Entebbe Flight Motel), about 570 km. Around noon our car broke down and was fixed in a local 'garage'. Left at 14.00. Drive along the entrance road to Lake Mburo NP, a.o. Bare-face Go-away-bird *Corythaixoides personata*. Unfortunately, the car broke down again but was (again) repaired by a local mechanic (17.00-19.00). Arrived at the hotel at 22.00.
- Mar 7 Left at 07.00 for a drive to MS. In Entebbe. Boat tour from 08.30 11.15 produced Shoebill Balaeniceps rex. Around noon, the local sewage works were visited for waders. Afternoon (14.30 19.00) was spent in the Imperial Botanical Garden (IBG) of Entebbe. Good views of an unexpected White-backed Night-Heron Gorsachius leuconotus, Grey Parrots Psittacus erithacus and Orange Weaver Ploceus aurantius. Direct flight from Entebbe (22.55) to Amsterdam (05.40; KL 0562).



### General

Although Uganda is situated at the Equator, it was neither unpleasantly hot nor humid at this time of the year. The country virtually lacks infrastructure, such as supply of drinking water, etc. The digital era has not yet arrived and officials are still fond of stamps. Most roads are unpaved and very dusty. Early morning and afternoon, children —most of them wearing school uniforms and without shoes- and adults are walking to either school or work, some carrying fruits or water. Most of the original forests seem to have been replaced by banana plantations. Bananas are used for preparing matoke, apparently Uganda's national dish. People are very polite and friendly despite their poverty. Surprisingly, cellular phones can be used almost anywhere. Local currency is shillings, but e.g. entrance fees of National Parks are paid in USD. After paying entrance fees, an additional fee has to be paid to allow bird watching within the park boundaries! Please note that only new dollar bills are accepted. Traffic is amazing, especially in Kampala.

#### **UGANDA 2008**

#### **PELECANIDAE**

1. **Pink-backed Pelican** *Pelecanus rufescens* Common in QENP (Feb 29 – Mar 2) and Entebbe (Mar 7).

#### **PHALACROCORACIDAE**

- 2. **Long-tailed Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax africanus* Seen at MFNP (6 birds, Feb 24) and MS (10 birds, Mar 7).
- 3. **Great Cormorant**. *Phalacrocorax carbo lucidus*. Common (about 150 birds) at QENP (Mar 1).

#### **ANHINGIDAE**

4. **Darter** Anhinga melanogaster
Good numbers (20) during the boat tour in MFNP (20+; Feb 24).

#### **ARDEIDAE**

- 5. **Grey Heron** *Ardea cinerea cinerea*Seen on various days during the tour. Most common (10) during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24).
- 6. **Black-headed Heron** *Ardea melanocephala*Seen on five days during the tour, most common at Kibo when travelling to MFNP (Feb 23).
- 7. **Goliath Heron** *Ardea goliath* About 5 birds seen during the boat tour at MFNP (Feb 24).
- 8. **Purple Heron** *Ardea purpurea purpurea*Also common on the boat tour (10) at MFNP (Feb 24) and MS (Mar 7).





- Great Egret Ardea alba
   Seen at Bugungu Wildlife Reserve (Feb 23), MFNP, QENP and MS.
- Intermediate Egret Egretta intermedia
   Only seen during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24).
- Little Egret Egretta garzetta
   Small numbers at MFNP, QENP and MS.
- 12. **Squacco Heron** *Ardeola ralloides* Seen in MFNP and QENP.

- 13. **Cattle Egret** *Bubulcus ibis ibis*Seen in good numbers in MFNP, QENP and MS.
- Striated Heron Butorides striata
   Two single birds in the IBG of Entebbe (Mar 7).
- 15. **Black-crowned Night-Heron** *Nycticorax nycticorax nycticorax* A single juvenile during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24).
- 16. **White-backed Night-Heron** *Gorsachius leuconotus* Good views of a single bird at the IBG (Mar 7).
- 17. **Little Bittern** *Ixobrychus minutus*Brief views of an adult bird in a papyrus stand (MS, Mar 7).

#### **SCOPIDAE**

18. **Hamerkop** *Scopus umbretta umbretta* Seen in MFNP, QENP and MS.

#### CICONIIDAE

- Yellow-billed Stork Mycteria ibis
   Two birds in QENP (Mar 1).
- 20. **African Open-billed Stork** *Anastomus lamelligerus lamelligerus*A single bird in Bugungu Wildlife Reserve (Feb 23). About 30 birds in QENP (Mar 1) and at least 10 birds in the IBG of Entebbe (Mar 7).





- 21. **Abdim's Stork** *Ciconia abdimii* Common. An astonishing flock (estimated at least 3000 birds) of migrant birds during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24). Also seen on various other days of the tour.
- 22. **Saddle-billed Stork** *Ephippiorhynchus senegalensis* Two distant birds in QENP (Mar 1).
- 23. **Marabou Stork** *Leptoptilos crumeniferus* Widely distributed, common in towns and villages. Abundant in Kampala (200+ on Feb 23).

#### **BALAENICIPIDIDAE**

24. **Shoebill** *Balaeniceps rex* Stunning views of two birds in MS (Mar 7).



# **THRESKIONITHIDAE**

- 25. **Sacred Ibis** *Threskiornis aethiopicus aethiopicus*Seen in low numbers in Bugungu Wildlife Reserve (Feb 23) and QENP.
- 26. **Hadada Ibis** *Bostrychia hagedash* Seen in MFNP, QENP and the IBG of Entebbe.

# PHOENICOPTHERIDAE

27. **Greater Flamingo** *Phoenicopterus ruber*Seen in a small lake along the entrance road (Mweya Gate) to QENP (Feb 29).

#### **ANATIDAE**

- 28. **Fulvous Whistling Duck** *Dendrocygna bicolor* A single bird in MFNP (Feb 24).
- 29. White-faced Whistling Duck Dendrocygna viduata
  Common (40-50 birds) in MFNP (Feb 24) and in MS (Mar 7).





- 30. **Egyptian Goose** Alopochen aegyptiaca Seen in MFNP, QENP and IBG.
- 31. **Spur-winged Goose** *Plectropterus gambensis gambensis* Relatively uncommon, only seen (4-5 birds) during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24).
- 32. **Yellow-billed Duck** *Anas undulata* Seen in good numbers (100+) in MS (Mar 7). Few birds in IBG of Entebbe (Mar 7).

#### **PANDIONIDAE**

33. **Osprey** *Pandion haliaetus*A single bird in MFNP (Feb 24) and 2 birds in MS (Mar 7).

#### **ACCIPITRIDAE**

- 34. **Bat Hawk** *Macheiramphus alcinus* A single bird in Entebbe (Mar 7).
- 35. **Black-shouldered Kite** *Elanus caeruleus*Rather common, seen on at least 7 days during the tour (1-5 birds/day).
- 36. **Yellow-billed Kite** *Milvus* (*migrans*) *parasiticus*By far the most common raptor. Seen on most days of the tour, up to 100+/day.



- 37. **African Fish-Eagle** *Haliaeetus vocifer* Common in MFNP, QENP and in MS.
- 38. **Palm-nut Vulture** *Gypohierax angolensis* Seen on 4 days during the tour (1-2 birds/day).
- 39. White-backed Vulture Gyps africanus
  The most common vulture. Seen at QENP.
- 40. **Hooded Vulture** *Necrosyrtes monachus* Seen in Kampala (Feb 23) and Entebbe (Mar 7).
- 41. **Lappet-faced Vulture** *Torgos tracheliotus*Two single birds during the game drive in MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 42. White-headed Vulture Trigonoceps occipitalis

Good views of a single adult bird along the entrance road to QENP (Mar 1).

#### 43. Black-chested (Black-breasted) Snake-Eagle Circaetus pectoralis

Two birds in QENP (Mar 1) and singles on both Mar 6 and Mar 7.

#### 44. Brown Snake-Eagle Circaetus cinereus

Single birds on Feb 29 and Mar 1 (QENP) and MS (Mar 7).

#### 45. Western Banded Snake-Eagle Circaetus cinerascens

Singles on Feb 23 (Hoi) and Mar 1 (QENP).

#### 46. Bateleur Terathopius ecaudatus

Seen in both MFNP and QENP (3-5 birds/day). Also along the entrance road to Lake Mburo NP (Mar 6).

#### 47. Western Marsh-Harrier Circus aeruginosus aeruginosus

Several males and females in QENP (Mar 1). Singles on Mar 6 and 7.

#### 48. African Marsh-Harrier Circus ranivorus

Seen on 5 days, 1-3 birds/day.

#### 49. Montagu's Harrier Circus pygargus

Seen on 3 days.

#### 50. African Harrier-Hawk (Gymnogyne) Polyboroides typus typus

A single bird on Feb 29 (QENP), 3 birds on Mar 6 (Rwabigangura) and a single bird on Mar 7 (MS).

#### 51. **Lizard Buzzard** Kaupifalco monogrammicus

Singles on Feb 26 (BNP) and 27 (KNP). Stunning views of a perched bird in the IBG (Mar 7).

#### 52. Shikra Accipiter badius

Singles seen only in MFNP (Feb 23-25).

### 53. Little Sparrowhawk Accipiter minullus

Beautiful scope views of a perched bird during the car repair at Mbarara (Mar 6).

#### 54. Black (Great) Goshawk Accipiter melanoleucus

A single bird on Mar 4 (Buhoma, BINP).

# 55. Grasshopper Buzzard Butastur rufipennis

Seen in MFNP, 2 birds on Feb 24 and 3 birds on Feb 25.

#### 56. Eurasian Buzzard Buteo buteo

About 7 birds on Feb 25 (MFNP), of which 4 of the race vulpinus. Two birds at Nyabubara (Chimps' Nest, Feb 28; KNP).

#### 57. Mountain Buzzard Buteo oreophilus

A single bird heard on Mar 3 (Ruhija, Mubwindi Swamp Track) and a single bird seen on Mar 4 (Kitahurira, BINP)).

#### 58. Augur Buzzard Buteo augur

Singles on Mar 2 and 3 (Ruhija).

# 59. **European Honey-Buzzard** *Pernis apivorus*

Singles on Feb 28 (KNP) and Mar 1 (QENP).

#### 60. Imperial Eagle Aguila heliaca

Good views of a single migrant flying over the entrance road to Mweya Gate (QENP, Feb 29).

### 61. **Tawny Eagle** Aquila rapax

Two birds on Feb 24 (MFNP), 1 single bird on Feb 29 (QENP) and 3 birds on Mar 6 (entrance road to Lake Mburo NP).

#### 62. Wahlberg's Eagle Aquila wahlbergi

A single bird on Feb 25 (MFNP). Three birds near MS (Mar 7).

### 63. Booted Eagle Hieraaetus pennatus

A single bird on Feb 25 (MFNP).

# 64. Martial Eagle Polemaetus bellicosus

A single perched bird at QENP (Mar 1).

#### 65. Long-crested Eagle Lophaetus occipitalis

A rather common raptor. Seen on at least 6 days, 1-4 birds/day.

#### 66. Cassin's Hawk-Eagle Spizaetus africanus

Two immature birds, most likely this species, on Feb 28 (KNP).

#### 67. African Crowned Eagle Stephanoaetus coronatus

Two birds in BNP (Feb 26), a single immature bird (Feb 27) and a single adult bird in KNP (Feb 28).



#### **FALCONIDAE**

#### 68. Gray Kestrel Falco ardosiaceus

The most common Falcon seen. Seen in MFNP (Feb 23-25), QENP and MS. Also seen while driving on various days.

#### 69. Red-necked Falcon Falco chicquera ruficollis

A single flying bird during the afternoon boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24).

# 70. **Eurasian Hobby** Falco subbuteo

An immature bird flying over the IBG of Entebbe (Mar 7).

# 71. **African Hobby** Falco cuvierii

Single birds on Feb 27 (KNP) and in Entebbe (Mar 7).

# 72. Peregrine Falcon Falco peregrinus minor

A single bird on Mar 25 (MFNP).

#### **PHASIANIDAE**

#### 73. Crested Francolin Francolinus sephaena grantii

Three birds on both Feb 24 and 25 (MFNP). Heard in KNP (Feb 28).

# 74. Red-winged Francolin Francolinus levaillantii

A single bird in QENP (Feb 29).

#### 75. **Scaly Francolin** Francolinus squamatus

Two birds on Feb 27 (KNP).

- 76. **Handsome Francolin** *Francolinus nobilis* Heard on Mar 3 (Mubwindi Swamp Track; Ruhija).
- 77. **Heuglin's Francolin** *Francolinus icterorhynchus* Common in MFNP (Feb 24-25).
- 78. **Red-necked Spurfowl** *Francolinus afer cranchii* Very common (30+/day) in QENP (Mar 1 and 2).

#### **NUMIDIDAE**

- 79. **Helmeted Guineafowl** *Numida meleagris meleagris* Common in both MFNP and QENP.
- 80. **Crested Guineafowl** *Guttera pucherani verreauxi* A single bird near the Royal Mile (BNP) on Feb 26.

#### **TURNICIDAE**

81. **Small Buttonquail** *Turnix sylvatica lepuranus*A nice surprise! A single bird crossing the road in front of the car in QENP (Mar 1).

#### **GRUIDAE**

82. **Gray Crowned Crane** *Balearica regulorum gibbericeps*Seen on 4 days (2-3 birds/day). First seen in a small swamp while driving to MFNP (Feb 23).





#### **RALLIDAE**

83. **Black Crake** *Amaurornis flavirostra*Various birds (at least 4) seen during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24). A single bird in the IBG of Entebbe (Mar 7).

84. **African Crake** *Crex egregria*Also a nice surprise. Five single birds seen in QENP (Mar 1), likely all intra-African migrants.

#### **OTIDIDAE**

85. **Black-bellied Bustard** *Eupodotis melanogaster melanogaster*A single female on Feb 24 (at Bugungu Wildlife Reserve, near MFNP). Good views of a single male and a total of 4 females in QENP (mar 1).

#### **JACANIDAE**

86. **Lesser Jacana** *Microparra capensis* About 6 birds in MS (Mar 7).

87. **African Jacana** *Actophilornis africanus* Common in both QENP (25+ birds/day) and MS.





#### RECURVIROSTRIDAE

88. **Black-winged Stilt** *Himantopus himantopus*Two distant birds in QENP (Mar 1) and also 2 birds on Mar 7 (IBG).

#### **BURHINIDAE**

- 89. **Water Thick-knee** *Burhinus vermiculatus vermiculatus*Two birds in QENP (Feb 29 and Mar 1) and 2 birds near the entrance road to Lake Mburo NP (Mar 6).
- 90. **Senegal Thick-knee** *Burhinus senegalensis* A single bird during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24).

#### GLAREOLIDAE

- 91. **Temminck's Courser** *Cursorius temminckii* Good scope views of 4 birds along the entrance road to Mweya Gate (QENP, Feb 29).
- 92. **Rock Pratincole** *Glareola nuchalis muchalis* Four birds during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24).

#### **CHARADRIIDAE**

- 93. **Long-toed Lapwing** *Vanellus crassirostris crassirostris* Common (20+ birds) in MFNP (Feb 24) and in MS (Mar 7).
- 94. **Spur-winged Plover** *Vanellus spinosus* Common, seen in MFNP, QENP and MS.





### 95. Senegal Lapwing Vanellus lugubris

Beautiful views of a single bird along the entrance road to QENP (Feb 29). Another 10 birds in QENP (Mar 1) and a flock of 14 birds along the entrance road to Lake Mburo NP (Mar 6).





# 96. **Crowned Lapwing** *Vanellus coronatus coronatus* Only seen in QENP (Feb 29 and Mar 1).

# 97. Wattled Lapwing Vanellus senegallus

Seen in QENP, 8 birds on Mar 1 and a single bird on Mar 2.

# 98. Kittlitz's Plover Charadrius pecuarius

Four birds at the local airstrip near Mweya (QENP) on Mar 1.

#### **SCOLOPACIDAE**

# 99. African Snipe Gallinago nigripennis aequatorialis

A single bird in the swamp at Kibo (Kiboga) in a small marsh where we also saw Gray Crowned Crane when travelling to MFNP (Feb 23).

# 100. Common Snipe Gallinago gallinago gallinago

A single bird at MS (Mar 7).

#### 101. Marsh Sandpiper Tringa stagnatilis

Three birds at the sewage works near Entebbe (Mar 7).

# 102. Common Greenshank Tringa nebularia

Two birds in MFNP (Feb 24) and a single bird at the sewage works (Mar 7).

#### 103. Green Sandpiper Tringa ochropus

Two birds at the sewage works near Entebbe (Mar 7).

# 104. Wood Sandpiper Tringa glareola

Four birds at Kiboga (Feb 23). At least 6 birds near Entebbe (Mar 7).

# 105. Common Sandpiper Actitis hypoleucos

Three birds at MFNP (Feb 24) and 14 birds in MS and Entebbe (Mar 7).

#### 106. Little Stint Calidris minuta

Two birds at the sewage works near Entebbe (Mar 7).

#### 107. Temminck's Stint Calidris temminckii

A single bird at the sewage works near Entebbe (Mar 7).

# 108. Ruff Philomachus pugnax

Also a single bird at the sewage works near Entebbe (Mar 7).

#### LARIDAE

#### 109. Black-backed Gull Larus ridibundus

A single bird flying over Lake Victoria (IBG, Mar 7).

#### 110. Gull-billed Tern Sterna nilotica nilotica

About 15 birds in QENP (Mar 1) and 25+ birds over Lake Victoria (IBG, Mar 7).

#### 111. White-winged Tern Chlidonias leucopterus

Five birds QENP (Mar 1) and 500+ birds migrating in flocks over Lake Victoria (IBG, Mar 7).

#### **RYNCHOPIDAE**

# 112. African Skimmer Rynchops flavirostris

Common (150+) along the Nile (MFNP, Feb 24) and (300+) QENP (Mar 1).

#### **COLUMBIDAE**

#### 113. Feral (Rock) Pigeon Columba livia

Common, seen on various days.

#### 114. Rameron (Olive) Pigeon Columba arguatrix

A stunning bird when observed well. Seen daily from Mar 1 – Mar 4 (2-3 birds/day; mainly BINP).

### 115. Red-eyed Dove Streptopelia semitorquata

Common, seen on many days of the tour. First seen on Feb 24 (MFNP).

#### 116. Ring-necked Dove Streptopelia capicola tropica

Seen at both MFNP (Feb 24-25) and QENP (Mar 1-2).

#### 117. Vinaceous Dove Streptopelia vinacea

Seen on several days, e.g. 2 birds on Feb 22 (MFNP).

# 118. Laughing Dove Streptopelia senegalensi senegalensis

Beautiful scope views of 2 birds at Mweya (QENP, Mar 1).

#### 119. Blue-spotted Wood-Dove Turtur afer

Single bird on Feb 27 and two birds on Feb 28 (KNP). Also seen on various other days.

# 120. Tambourine Dove Turtur tympanistria

Seen in KNP (Feb 27-28) and on Mar 5 (BINP).

#### 121. African Green-Pigeon Treron calvus salvadorii

Seen in KNP (Feb 27-28). Good views of 10 birds in the single fruiting tree at the "garage" during the car repair (Mar 6).

#### **PSITTACIDAE**

#### 122. Gray Parrot Psittacus erithacus erithacus

Several birds flying along the entrance road to MS and flying over MS (Mar 7). Stunning views of 2 birds in the IBG of Entebbe (Mar 7).

#### 123. Brown (Meyer's) Parrot Poicephalus meyeri saturatus

Seen on 3 days, best views of 2 birds at the local sewage ponds near Entebbe (Mar 7).

#### **MUSOPHAGIDAE**

#### 124. Great Blue Turaco Corythaeola cristata

This beautiful and rather noisy bird seen on 6 days. Already seen when travelling to MFNP (Feb 23), but also in KNP (Feb 27-28), BINP (Mar 3 and 5) and MS (Mar 7).



# 125. **Black-billed Turaco** *Tauraco schuettii emini*Heard and briefly seen in KNP (Feb 28). Often heard in BINP, good views of a single bird on Mar

# 126. **Ross' Turaco** *Musophaga rossae*Seen when travelling to KNP at Ikoba Swamp (Feb 27) and near Chimps' Nest at KNP (Feb 28). Also 2 birds at the IBG (Mar 7).

# 127. **Bare-faced Go-away-bird** *Corythaixoides personatus*Two birds at the Nshara entrance road to Lake Mburo NP (Mar 6).

# 128. **Eastern Plantain-eater** *Crinifer zonurus*Often seen and heard during the tour. First seen when travelling to MFNP (Feb 24).

#### **CUCULIDAE**

# 129. **Pied Cuckoo** *Clamator jacobinus pica*Good views of two birds on Feb 25 (MFNP).

# Levaillant's Cuckoo Clamator levaillantii A single bird at Nyabubara (Chimps' Nest; KNP, Feb 28).

# Red-chested Cuckoo Cuculus solitarius By far the most common Cuckoo. Heard on almost all days, first seen on Feb 27 (KNP).

# 132. **Black Cuckoo** *Cuculus clamosus gabonensis*A single bird at Kiboga when travelling to MFNP (Feb 23).

# 133. **African Cuckoo** *Cuculus gularis* A single bird at Masi (MFNP, MFNP).

# 134. **Dusky Long-tailed Cuckoo** *Cercococcyx mechowi*Good views of a single bird at Budungo (KNP, Feb 26). Heard on 4 other days.

# 135. Olive Long-tailed Cuckoo Cercococcyx olivinus Heard on Feb 27 (KNP). Seen at Kitahurira on Mar 4 (BINP).

# 136. Barred Long-tailed Cuckoo Cercococcyx montanus montanus

Good views of a single bird at the School Track (Ruhija, Mar 4).

#### 137. Klaas' Cuckoo Chrysococcyx klaas

Heard on various days, but stunning views of an adult bird apparently feeding two immature birds near Mweya (QENP; Mar 1).

#### 138. African Emerald Cuckoo Chrysococcyx cupreus

Heard on various days, a female seen on Feb 28 near Chimps Nest (KNP).

# 139. Diederic Cuckoo Chrysococcyx caprius

A single bird seen well from our banda at Chimps Nest (KNP, Feb 28).

# 140. Yellowbill Ceuthmochares aereus aereus

Only heard on Feb 25 and 26 (BNP).

#### 141. Blue-headed Coucal Centropus monachus fischeri

Singles on Feb 25 and 27 during road side stops at (papyrus) swamps.

#### 142. White-browed Coucal Centropus superciliosus loandae

Rather common, seen on various days, e.g. when travelling to MFNP (Feb 23).

#### **STRIGIDAE**

### 143. Spotted (Grayish) Eagle Owl Bubo africanus

A single bird during a spot light tour on Feb 24 (MFNP).

## 144. Verreaux's Eagle-Owl Bubo lacteus

A single bird perched on top of a tree in full daylight (QENP, Mar 1).

#### 145. African Wood-Owl Strix woodfordii nuchalis

Good views of a single bird during a spot light tour on Feb 28 (Rougongo, KNP).

#### CAPRIMULGIDAE

### 146. Square-tailed Nightjar Caprimulgus fossii

Three birds in MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 147. Black-shouldered Nightjar Caprimulgus nigriscapularis

A single bird during the spot light tour on Feb 28 (Rougongo, KNP).

# 148. Standard-winged Nightjar Macrodipteryx longipennis

Very poor views of a bird flying over our car (Feb 23, MFNP).

#### **APODIDAE**

#### 149. Sabine's Spinetail Rhaphidura sabini

About 10 birds seen flying over the forest of BNP (Feb 26).

# 150. African Palm-Swift Cypsiurus parvus myochrous

Common, seen especially during the first half of the tour, e.g. in MFNP.

#### 151. Alpine Swift Tachymarptis melba

Seen during 5 days of the tour, 2-10 birds/day.

### 152. Common Swift Apus apus

Common, seen on many days of the tour.

#### 153. Little Swift Apus affinis aerobatus

Most common in QENP, 150+ birds on Mar 1.

# 154. White-rumped Swift Apus caffer

Seen on 4 days, 2-5 birds/day, e.g. on Feb 27 (KNP).

#### **COLIIDAE**

#### 155. Speckled Mousebird Colius striatus kiwuensis

Common, seen on most days of the tour. At MFNP race jebelensis.

# 156. Blue-naped Mousebird Urocolius macrourus griseogularis

Seen in MFNP (2 birds on Feb 24), QENP and on Mar 6.

#### **TROGONIDAE**

#### 157. Narina Trogon Apaloderma narina brachyurum

Stunning views of a beautiful male at Budongo (Royal Mile, BNP; Feb 26).

# 158. Bar-tailed Trogon Apaloderma vittatum

Beautiful views of a single adult male at Buhoma (BINP, Mar 5).

#### **ALCEDINIDAE**

# 159. Shining-blue Kingfisher Alcedo quadribrachys guentheri

Stunning views of a perched bird at close range at Nyabubara (Chimps' Nest, KNP; Feb 28).

# 160. Malachite Kingfisher Alcedo cristata cristata

Seen during the boat tour on the Nile (MFNP, Feb 24; 10 birds) and in MS (4 birds) on Mar 7.



# 161. White-bellied Kingfisher Alcedo leucogaster leopoldi

Brief views of a diving bird at a small river at the Royal Mile (BNP, Feb 26).

#### 162. African Pygmy-Kingfisher Ispidina picta picta

Good views of single birds at Budongo (Royal Mile, BNP; Feb 26) and QENP (Mar 1 and 2).

#### 163. Dwarf Kingfisher Ispidina lecontei

Good views of two birds in BNP (Royal Mile; Feb 26).

#### 164. Chocolate-backed Kingfisher Halcyon badia

Singles in BNP (Feb 25-26). More birds heard on both dates.

#### 165. Gray-headed Kingfisher Halcyon leucocephala

Common in MFNP (Feb 24 and 25; 10-20+/day) and somewhat less common in QENP (Mar 1 and 2; 2-4 birds/day).

#### 166. Woodland Kingfisher Halcyon senegalensis senegalensis

Three birds seen at Kiboga while travelling to MFNP (Feb 23), to KNP (Feb 27) and MS (Mar 7).

# 167. Blue-breasted Kingfisher Halcyon malimbica malimbica

Beautiful views of a single bird seen very well at Budongo (Royal Mile, BNP; Feb 26). Other birds heard on Feb 26 and 28.

#### 168. Striped Kingfisher Halcyon chelicuti chelicuti

A single bird along the Nshara Gate Road to Lake Mburo NP (Mar 6).

#### 169. Giant Kingfisher Megaceryle maximus maximus

Single birds seen during the Nile boat tour (MFNP, Feb 24) and on Feb 25.

#### 170. Pied Kingfisher Ceryle rudis rudis

Common. Seen in good numbers in MFNP (Feb 23-24), QENP (Mar 1) and IBG (Mar 7).

#### **MEROPIDAE**

#### 171. Black Bee-eater Merops gularis australis

Good views of single birds at BINP (Mar 4 and 5).

#### 172. Little Bee-eater Merops pusillus pusillus

Seen on 5 days of the tour, first seen in MFNP (Feb 24).

# 173. Blue-breasted Bee-eater Merops variegates loringi

Only seen near the 'harbour' of MS (Mar 7).

#### 174. Common Bee-eater Merops apiaster

Three birds seen while travelling from MFNP to BNP (Feb 25). Singles on Mar 1 and 2 (QENP).

#### 175. Cinnamon-chested Bee-eater Merops oreobates

Most birds seen near Ruhija, e.g. 20+ birds on Mar 2.

#### 176. Swallow-tailed Bee-eater Merops hirundineus heuglini

About 8 birds in during the game drive in MFNP (Feb 24).

# 177. White-throated Bee-eater Merops albicollis

Seen on 5 days, e.g. 6 birds in BNP (Feb 25).

#### 178. Blue-cheeked Bee-eater Merops persicus persicus

Seen on 4 days, highest count of 9 birds on Feb 27 (KNP).

# 179. Northern Carmine Bee-eater Merops nubicus

This rather large Bee-eater seen on the boat tour in MFNP (10 birds, Feb 24). Another 2 birds on Feb 25, apparently far from water.

# 180. Red-throated Bee-eater Merops bulocki frenatus

Common during the Nile boat tour at MFNP (100+ birds, Feb 24). About 50+ birds in MFNP on Feb 25.



#### **CORACIIDAE**

- Lilac-breasted Roller Coracias caudatus caudatus
   Two birds seen along the Nshara Gate road to Lake Mburo NP (Mar 6).
- 182. **Rufous-crowned Roller** *Coracias noevius noevius* A single bird seen during the game drive in MFNP (Feb 24).
- 183. **Broad-billed Roller** *Eurystomus glaucurus suahelicus*Common, seen on 7 days of the tour, e.g. 6 birds when driving from Entebbe to MFNP (Feb 23).
- 184. **Blue-throated Roller** *Eurystomus gularis neglectus* A total of five birds at Budongo (Royal Mile, Feb 26).

#### **UPUPIDAE**

185. **African Hoopoe** *Upupa africana* A single bird near Mweija (QENP, Mar 1).

# RHINOPOMASTIDAE

- 186. **Common Scimitar-bill** *Rhinopomastus cyanomelas schalowi* One bird in QENP (Mar 1).
- 187. **Black Scimitarbill** *Rhinopomastus aterrimus emini* A single bird in MFNP (Feb 24).

#### **BUCEROTIDAE**

- 188. Crowned Hornbill Tockus alboterminatus Good (scope) views of a single bird at KNP (Feb 28). Another single bird on Mar 4 (BINP) and 4 birds at the IBG (Mar 7).
- 189. **African Pied Hornbill** *Tockus fasciatus fasciatus* Two birds on Feb 26 (BNP) and a single bird on Mar 7 (MS).
- 190. **African Gray Hornbill** *Tockus nasutus nasutus* Common in MFNP (6 birds on Feb 24 and 4 birds on Feb 25). Also seen on at least 2 other days.

- 191. **Black-and-white-casqued Hornbill** *Ceratogymna subcylindrica subquadratus* Likely the most common Hornbill seen. First distant bird seen during the boat tour in MFNP (Feb 24). Seen on 8 days, e.g. at the Royal Mile (BNP) and KNP.
- 192. White-thighed Hornbill Ceratogymna albotibialis Seen at the Budongo (BNP, Feb 25-26).



193. **Abyssinian Ground-Hornbill** *Bucorvus abyssinicus*Three birds seen before entering MFNP (Feb 23). During the game drive, a total of 7 birds in MFNP (Feb 24). On Feb 25 a close bird, apparently perched in a roadside tree, flew off (MFNP).

#### **CAPITONIDAE**

- 194. **Yellow-billed Barbet** *Trachyphonus purpuratus elgonenesis*A calling bird (only it's head!) seen at Nyabubara (Chimps' Nest, KNP; Feb 28). Heard on Mar 3 (BINP).
- 195. **Gray-throated Barbet** *Gymnobucco bonapartei cineireiceps* Erect bristle-tufts are a striking feature! Seen on 5-6 days, e.g. 4 birds on Feb 26 (BNP).
- 196. **Speckled Tinkerbird** *Pogoniulus scolopaceus flavisquamatus*A single bird at Kitahurira (Mar 4, BINP). Also a single bird on Mar 5. Various others heard.
- 197. **Yellow-throated Tinkerbird** *Pogoniulus subsulphureus flavimentum* Common at BNP (Feb 25 and 26). A single bird in QENP (Mar 2).
- 198. Yellow-rumped Tinkerbird Pogoniulus bilineatus leucolaimus Seen on 6 days (1-2 birds/day), first on Feb 25 (BNP). Race mfumbiri seen at the School Track and Mubwindi Swamp Track near Ruhija.
- 199. **Yellow-fronted Tinkerbird** *Pogoniulus chrysoconus chrysoconus* Heard on 2 days, a single bird seen near Mweya (Feb 29).
- 200. **Yellow-spotted Barbet** *Buccanodon duchaillui* Heard only on Feb 25 (BNP) and 28 (KNP).

# 201. Hairy-breasted Barbet Tricholaema hirsute ansorgii

Good views of 2 birds at KNP (Feb 28).

### 202. Spot-flanked Barbet Tricholaema lacrymosa radcliffei

Close views of single birds on Feb 29 and Mar 1 (QENP).

#### **INDICATORIDAE**

#### 203. Least Honeyguide Indicator exilis

The only Honeyguide seen during the tour. A single bird near Ruhija (BINP) on Mar 2.

#### **PICIDAE**

### 204. Tullberg's Woodpecker Campethera tullbergi taeniolaima

A single bird along the School Track (Ruhija, BINP; Mar 4).

#### 205. Buff-spotted Woodpecker Campethera nivosa herberti

A single female at Buhoma on Mar 5 (BINP).

#### 206. Brown-eared Woodpecker Campethera caroli caroli

A single bird at Budongo (Kaniyo Pabidi) on Feb 25. Another heard on Mar 4.

#### 207. Cardinal Woodpecker Dendropicos fuscescens lepidus

Two birds along the Royal Mile (BNP, Feb 26). Singles on Mar 2 and 3 (BINP).

#### 208. Golden-crowned Woodpecker Dendropicos xantholophus

Two birds in BNP on both Feb 25 and 26.

#### 209. Elliot's Woodpecker Dendropicos elliotii elliotii

Three birds seen well on May 5 (BINP).

#### **EURYLAIMIDAE**

#### 210. African Broadbill Smithornis capensis meinertzhageni

A single bird heard on Mar 5 (BINP).

#### ALAUDIDAE

# 211. Flappet Lark Mirafra rufocinnamomea torrida / kawirondensis

Seen in MFNP (torrida: 3 birds, Feb 24) and in QENP (kawirondensis: Feb 29 and Mar 1).

#### HIRUNDINIDAE

#### 212. Bank Swallow Riparia riparia riparia

Seen on 8 days in good numbers (10-100+/day).

# 213. Banded Martin Riparia cincta suahelica

A single bird at Budongo (BNP, Feb 26).

#### 214. Rock Martin Ptyonoprogne fuligula fusciventris

Seen on Mar 2 and 3 near Ruhija (BINP).


# 215. Barn Swallow Hirundo rustica rustica

Common, seen on almost all days of the tour in substantial numbers.

#### 216. Angola Swallow Hirundo angolensis

Beautiful views of several birds perched on our hostel at Mweya (QENP, Mar 1). Also seen in low numbers in BINP (both Mar 4 and 5).

# 217. **Wire-tailed Swallow** *Hirundo smithii smithii* Good views of at least 10 birds along the Nile at MFNP (Feb 24).



- 218. **Lesser Striped-Swallow** *Cecropis abyssinica unitatis* Seen on 4 days, e.g. 20+ birds on Feb 25 (MFNP).
- 219. **Rufous-chested Swallow** *Cecropis semirufa gordoni* Six birds on Mar 1 (QENP).
- 220. **Mosque Swallow** *Cecropis senegalensis saturatior* Seen on 3 days, e.g. at QENP (Feb 29).
- 221. **Red-rumped Swallow** *Cecropis daurica emini* Five birds at Ruhija (School Track, BINP; Mar 2).
- 222. **House Martin** *Delichon urbicum* A single bird seen in MFNP (Feb 24).
- 223. White-headed Sawwing Psalidoprocne albiceps albiceps
  Common at Budongo (KNP, Feb 25 and 26). Also seen in QENP (Mar 1).
- 224. **Black Sawwing** *Psalidoprocne pristoptera*Seen along the School Track and Mubwindi Swamp Track near Ruhija (BINP, Mar 2-4).

#### MOTACILLIDAE

- 225. **African Pied Wagtail** *Motacilla aguimp* Common, seen on almost all days of the tour (1-6 birds/day).
- 226. **Cape Wagtail** *Motacilla capensis welsii* A single bird seen well in MS (Mar 7).
- 227. **Yellow Wagtail** *Motacilla flava* Common, seen on many days of the tour. Various races, including ssp. *Lutea* and *thunbergi*.
- 228. **Yellow Wagtail** *Motacilla flava flavissima* Singles at MFNP (Feb 24) and Entebbe (Mar 7).
- 229. **Mountain Wagtail** *Motacilla clara*A single bird perched on a rock in a rivulet (KNP, Feb 28).

#### 230. Yellow-throated Longclaw Macronyx croceus

Seen on 7 days, first seen during the game drive in MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 231. Grassland (African) Pipit Anthus cinnamomeus lichenya

Two birds on Feb 28 (BNP). Common (20+) along the entrance road to QENP (Mar 1).

#### **CAMPEPHAGIDAE**

#### 232. Gray Cuckoo-shrike Coracina caesia

Seen daily in BINP (Mar 2-5).

#### 233. Petit's Cuckoo-shrike Campephaga petiti

A single male on Mar 2 and several females on Mar 3-5 (BINP).

#### 234. Black Cuckoo-shrike Campephaga flava

A single male seen from our balcony in Bwindi (BINP, Mar 5).

#### **PYCNONOTIDAE**

#### 235. Common Bulbul Pycnonotus barbatus tricolor

Very common, seen on all days of the tour, up to 20+ birds/day.

#### 236. Shelley's Greenbul Andropadus masukuensis kakamegae

Four birds at Buhoma (BINP, Mar 5).

#### 237. Little Greenbul Andropadus virens

Seen daily in mixed flocks from Feb 25 (BNP) – Feb 28 (KNP, 1-3 birds/day). Two birds in BINP (Mar 5).

#### 238. Plain (Sombre) Greenbul Andropadus curvirostris

Only seen at Budongo (Busingiro, Royal Mile) in BNP on Feb 25-26 (1-2 birds/day).

#### 239. Slender-billed Greenbul Andropadus gracilirostris

Seen in BNP (both Feb 25 and 26). A single bird in KNP (Feb 28) and 2 birds near Ruhija (BINP, Mar 3).

#### 240. Yellow-whiskered Greenbul Andropadus latirostris

Very striking whiskers indeed. Seen (4 birds) in KNP (Feb 27). Also seen (and heard) daily in BINP (Mar 2-5).

#### 241. Eastern Mountain-Greenbul Andropadus nigriceps kikuyuensis

Seen daily along School Track and Mubwindi Samp Track near Ruhija (BINP, Mar 2-4).

### 242. Spotted Greenbul Ixonotus guttatus

Only seen in BNP (Feb 25).

#### 243. Yellow-throated Greenbul Chlorocichla flavicollis

Two birds in BINP (Mar 2).

#### 244. Joyful Greenbul Chlorocichla laetissima

A single bird seen near KNP (Feb 27).

#### 245. Cabanis' Greenbul Phyllastrephus cabanisi

Two birds at KNP (Feb 27).

# 246. Toro Olive-Greenbul Phyllastrephus hypochloris

Heard on Feb 28 (KNP).

#### 247. Yellow-streaked Bulbul Phyllastrephus flavostriatus olivaceogriseus

Good views of this species near Ruhija on Mar 2-3 (BINP).

#### 248. White-throated Greenbul Phyllastrephus albigularis

Heard on Feb 25 (BNP).

#### 249. Common Bristlebill Bleda syndactylus

As previous species, but also heard at Buhoma (BINP, Mar 5).

#### 250. Western (Yellow-spotted) Nicator Nicator chloris

Singles seen at the Royal Mile (BNP, Feb 26) and in KNP (Feb 28-29).

#### 251. Red-tailed Greenbul Criniger calurus

Five birds in BNP (Feb 25). Also seen in BINP (Mar 4 and 5).

#### **TURDIDAE**

#### 252. Rufous Flycatcher-Thrush Neocossyphus fraseri

Heard on both Feb 25 (BNP) and 29 (KNP).

#### 253. Olive Thrush Turdus olivaceus olivaceus

A single bird along the School Track (Ruhija, BINP; Mar 2).

#### 254. African Thrush Turdus pelios

Seen daily (2-4 birds/day) in both KNP and QENP (Feb 27 – Mar 1).

#### 255. Red-throated Alethe Alethe poliophrys

Beautiful views of a perched bird in the forest undergrowth at Buhoma (Mar 5, BINP).

#### **SYLVIIDAE**

### 256. Red-faced Cisticola Cisticola erythrops

Seen at Kiboga (Feb 23), Budongo (Feb 26) and 2 others days.

# 257. Whistling Cisticola Cisticola lateralis

Singles seen during the game drive in MFNP (Feb 24) and on Feb 27.

#### 258. Trilling Cisticola Cisticola woosnami

A single bird along the Nshara Gate (entrance) road to Lake Mburo NP on Mar 6 (BINP).

#### 259. Chubb's Cisticola Cisticola chubby

Two birds on Feb 27 (KNP). Also along School Track and Mubwindi Swamp Track (Ruhija, Mar 2-4).

# 260. Rattling Cisticola Cisticola chiniana

A single bird during the game drive at MFNP (Feb 24, MFNP).

#### 261. Winding Cisticola Cisticola galactotes

A single bird at QENP (Mar 1). About 20 birds at MS (Mar 7).

# 262. Carruthers' Cisticola Cisticola carruthersi

Two birds in a papyrus swamp at Rwankore when travelling from Masindi (QENP) to KNP (Feb 27).

#### 263. Stout Cisticola Cisticola robustus

A single bird at MS (Mar 7).

#### 264. Croaking Cisticola Cisticola natalensis

About 20 birds during the game drive in MFNP (Feb 24). Also a single bird along the entrance road to Mweya Gate (QENP, Feb 29).

#### 265. Siffling Cisticola Cisticola brachypterus

A single bird in MFNP (Feb 25).

#### 266. Zitting Cisticola Cisticola juncidis

A single bird at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 267. Wing-snapping Cisticola Cisticola ayresii

A single bird at QENP (Mar 1).

#### 268. Tawny-flanked Prinia Prinia subflava

Common. Seen almost daily from Feb 23 to 28 (MFNP-KNP).

#### 269. Banded Prinia Prinia bairdii

A stunning little bird! Three birds seen when walking along the Mubwindi Swamp Track (BINP) on Mar 3. Also 2 birds on Mar 5 (Buhoma, BINP).

#### 270. White-chinned Prinia Prinia (Schistolais) leucopogon

Seen at Buhoma on Mar 4-5 (BINP).

#### 271. Red-winged Grey Warbler Drymocichla incana

Nice views of 4 birds in MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 272. Ruwenzori (Collared) Apalis Apalis ruwenzorii

A beautiful bird. Good views of a single bird from the School Track (Ruhija, Mar 2) and 5 birds on Mar 3 (Mubwindi Swamp Track and School Track; BINP).

#### 273. Black-throated Apalis Apalis jacksoni

Two birds at Budongo (Busingiro, Feb 25; BNP) and Royal Mile (BNP, Feb 25). Seen daily from Mar 3-5 (BINP).

# 274. Masked Apalis Apalis binotata

Three birds at KNP (Feb 27).

# 275. Black-faced (Mountain) Apalis Apalis personata personata

A single bird on Mar 2 (School Track) and 2 birds on Mar 3 (Mubwindi Swamp Track; BINP).

#### 276. Buff-throated Apalis Apalis rufogularis

Three birds at BNP (Busingiro, Feb 25) and at KFR (Feb 27-28).

#### 277. Chestnut-throated Apalis Apalis porphyrolaema

Six birds at the School Track (Ruhija, BINP) on Mar 2. Also a single bird seen and more heard on Mar 3 (BINP).

# 278. Gray-capped Warbler Eminia lepida

Beautiful views of this striking (large) warbler (3 birds) on Mar 1 (Mweya, QENP). Heard on Feb 27.

# 279. Green-backed Camaroptera Camaroptera brachyuran

Heard on many days. Singles seen on e.g. Mar 1 (QENP) and Mar 5 (BINP). In MFNP abessinica, tincta in BNP, KNP and QENP, aschani in Ruhija.

# 280. Olive-green Camaroptera Camaroptera chloronota

A single bird on Mar 5 (Buhoma, BINP).

#### 281. White-winged Scrub-Warbler Bradypterus carpalis

Good views of this very large papyrus warbler at a road stop when driving from Bwindi to Entebbe (Rwabigangura, Mar 6).

#### 282. Grauer's (Rush) Scrub-Warbler Bradypterus graueri

A single bird seen well at the Mubwindi Swamp Track (BINP, Mar 3).

#### 283. Cinnamon Bracken-Warbler Bradypterus cinnamomeus

Heard and very briefly seen (BVR) at the Mubwindi Swamp Track near Ruhija (Mar 3, BINP).

#### 284. Black-faced Rufous-Warbler Bathmocercus rufus

Poor views of this skulker at Kitahurira (Mar 3, BINP) and Buhoma (Mar 4, BINP).

#### 285. (African) Moustached (Grass-) Warbler Melocichla mentalis

Heard at Feb 27 (QENP). Good views of a single bird at Kihihi (Mar 2).

#### 286. Eurasian Reed-Warbler Acrocephalus scirpaceus

A single bird at MFNP (Feb 24). Also heard on Mar 1 (QENP).

#### 287. Greater Swamp-Warbler Acrocephalus rufescens

Two birds when travelling to KNP (Feb 27).

#### 288. Eastern Olivaceous Warbler Hippolais pallida

A single bird at the IBG of Entebbe (Mar 7).

#### 289. African Yellow Warbler Chloropeta natalensis

Singles at Nyabyeya, near the Royal Mile (BNP, Feb 26) and at the Ikoba Swamp (Feb 27).

#### 290. Mountain Yellow Warbler Chloropeta similes

A single bird briefly seen on the Mubwindi Swamp Track (Ruhija, Mar 3; BINP).

# 291. Rufous-crowned Eremomela Eremomela badiceps

Three birds on Feb 25 (BNP).

#### 292. Green Crombec Sylvietta virens

Good views of two birds at KNP (Feb 28).

#### 293. Lemon-bellied Crombec Sylvietta denti

Seen on 3 days, first bird on Feb 25 (KNP).

# 294. White-browed Crombec Sylvietta leucophrys

Good views of 2 birds at Ruhija (School Track, Mar 3; BINP).

#### 295. Green Hylia Hylia prasina

A single bird at BNP (Feb 25) and heard on Feb 28 (KNP).

# 296. Red-faced Woodland-Warbler Phylloscopus laetus

Good views of 6 birds on 3 days (School Track and Mubwindi Swamp Track, Mar 3-5; BINP).

#### 297. Willow Warbler Phylloscopus trochilus

Singles on 3-4 days, e.g. a bird at Feb 27 (KNP). Race acredula at Kagadi (Feb 27).

# 298. Wood Warbler Phylloscopus sibilatrix

A single bird seen from our banda at Buhoma (Mar 5, BINP).

#### 299. Blackcap Sylvia atricapilla

A small flock of 4 birds at the School Track near Ruhija (BINP, Mar 3).

# 300. Silverbird Empidornis semipartitus

Good views of 7 birds (MFNP, Feb 23-25).

#### 301. White-eyed Slaty-Flycatcher Melaenornis fischeri toruensis

Seen daily (Mar 2-5) at Ruhija (School Track) and Buhoma (1-4 birds/day).

# 302. **Northern Black-Flycatcher** *Melaenornis edolioides* A single bird on Feb 27 (KNP). Also seen in QENP (Feb 29-Mar 1).



- 303. **Yellow-eyed Black-Flycatcher** *Melaenornis ardesiacus* Three birds at the School Track on Mar 2 (Ruhija, BINP).
- 304. **Sooty Flycatcher** *Muscicapa infuscata* Singles on Mar 25 (BNP) and 28 (KNP).
- 305. **Swamp Flycatcher** *Muscicapa aquatica*Seen during the boat tour at MFNP (Feb 24). Common at QENP (Feb 29 Mar 1).
- 306. **African Dusky Flycatcher** *Muscicapa adusta* Common at Ruhija and Buhoma (Mar 2-5, BINP).
- 307. **Dusky-blue Flycatcher** *Muscicapa comitata* A single bird at Buhoma (Mar 2, BINP).
- 308. **Cassin's Flycatcher** *Muscicapa cassini* Two birds at a little river in KNP (Feb 27-28).
- 309. **Gray-throated (Tit-) Flycatcher** *Myioparus griseigularis* A single bird at the Royal Mile (BNP, Feb 26).
- 310. **Lead-coloured (Gray Tit-) Flycatcher** *Myioparus plumbeus* A single bird near Chimps' Nest (KNP, Feb 28).
- 311. **Forest Robin** *Stiphrornis erythrothorax xanthogaster* Beautiful views of a single bird at the Royal Mile (BNP, Feb 26).
- 312. **Equatorial Akalat** *Sheppardia aequatorialis* Good views of a single bird at Buhoma (Mar 5, BINP).
- 313. White-bellied Robin-Chat Cossyphicula roberti Only heard, seen by others, at BINP (Mar 5).
- 314. **Archer's Robin-Chat** Cossypha archeri
  A single bird, poorly seen, from the Mubwindi Swamp Track near Ruhija (Mar 3).

### 315. Gray-winged Robin-Chat Cossypha polioptera

Good views of a single singing bird at Buhoma (Mar 4, BINP).

#### 316. White-browed Robin-Chat Cossypha heuglini

Common at QENP (Feb 29-Mar 2).

#### 317. Red-capped (Natal) Robin-Chat Cossypha natalensis

Heard at Bwindi (Mar 5).

#### 318. Snowy-crowned Robin-Chat Cossypha niveicapilla

Heard on Feb 28 (KNP), a single bird briefly seen while driving from Ruhija to the Neck (Mar 4).

# 319. Spotted Morning-Thrush Cichladusa guttata guttata

A single bird at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 320. Brown-backed Scrub-Robin Cercotrichas hartlaubi

Two birds near Chimps' Nest (KNP, Feb 28)

#### 321. Whinchat Saxicola rubetra

Common, seen on many days during the tour.

#### 322. African Stonechat Saxicola torquatus axillaris

A male and female from the School Track (Ruhija, Mar 2).

#### 323. Northern Wheatear Oenanthe oenanthe

Ten birds at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 324. Sooty Chat Myrmecocichla nigra

A single bird at MFNP (Feb 24). Common at QENP (Feb 29 – Mar 2). Also 3 birds along the entrance road to Lake Mburo NP (Mar 6).

# 325. African Shrike-Flycatcher Bias (Megabyas) flammulatus

Seen at Budongo (Busingiro and Royal Mile on Feb 25 and 26, respectively).

#### 326. Black-and-white Shrike-Flycatcher Bias musicus musicus

Seen at KNP (Feb 27-28). Also seen at Buhoma (BINP, Mar 4-5).

# 327. Brown-throated Wattle-eye Platysteira cyanea

Two males at Buhoma (BINP, Mar 4).

#### 328. Chestnut Wattle-eye Platysteira castanea

Two males at BNP (Feb 25) and a female on Feb 26. Also a male and female at KNP (Feb 28).

### 329. Ruwenzori Batis Batis diops

Good views of 2 birds at Ruhija (School Track) on Mar 3 (BINP).

#### 330. Chinspot Batis Batis molitor

Seen on 2 days (1 bird/day) at Bwindi (Mar 3-4).

# 331. Ituri Batis Batis ituriensis

A single bird seen well at Busingiro (BNP, Feb 25).

#### 332. Black-headed Batis Batis minor

Singles at MFNP (Feb 24-25) and 2 birds at QENP (Mar 1).

#### MONARCHIDAE

#### 333. Chestnut-capped Flycatcher Erythrocercus mccallii

Six birds at BNP (Busingiro, Feb 25) and a single bird along the Royal Mile (Feb 26).

#### 334. African Blue-Flycatcher Elminia longicauda

Good views of 2 birds near at Kagadi (Mar 27).

#### 335. White-tailed Blue-Flycatcher Elminia albicauda

Common along both the School Track and Mubwindi Swamp Track near Ruhija (Mar 2-5).

#### 336. White-bellied Crested-Flycatcher Elminia albiventris

A single male at the Mubwindi Swamp Track (Ruhija, Mar 3).

#### 337. Black-headed Paradise-Flycatcher Terpsiphone rufiventer

Good views of a single bird at BNP (Busingiro, Feb 25). Also heard on Mar 2 (School Track near Ruhija).

### 338. African Paradise-Flycatcher Terpsiphone viridis

A female at BNP (ferretti; Feb 25). Race kivuensis common at Ruhija (Mar 2-5).

#### **TIMALIIDAE**

#### 339. Scaly-breasted Illadopsis Illadopsis albipectus

Heard on Feb 26 and 28 (BNP and KNP). A single bird trapped in a mist net on Mar 5 (BINP).

#### 340. Brown Illadopsis Illadopsis fulvescens

Brief views of a single bird at BNP (Busingiro, Feb 25).

#### 341. Mountain Illadopsis Illadopsis pyrrhoptera

Heard along the Mubwindi Swamp Track near Ruhija (Mar 5).

#### 342. African Hill Babbler Pseudoalcippe abyssinica atriceps

Good views of a single bird at the School Track near Ruhija (Mar 2). Heard on Mar 3 and 4.

### 343. Black-lored Babbler Turdoides sharpei sharpei

Singles at Nyabubara (Chimps' Nest, KNP, Feb 28) and along the entrance road (Mweija Gate) to QENP (Mweija Gate Feb 29).

# 344. Arrow-marked Babbler Turdoides jardineii

A single bird at QENP (Mar 1).

#### 345. Brown Babbler Turdoides plebejus

A single bird at MFNP (Feb 24).

### **PARIDAE**

# 346. White-shouldered Black-Tit Melaniparus guineensis

A single bird at MFNP (Feb 25).

#### 347. Dusky Tit Melaniparus funereus

Seen at BNP (Busingiro and Royal Mile, Feb 25-26) and at Buhoma (Mar 4-5).

# 348. Stripe-breasted Tit Melaniparus fasciiventer fasciiventer

Seen along the Mubwindi Swamp Track (BINP, Mar 3) and the approach road to Ruhija (Mar 4).

#### **NECTARINIIDAE**

#### 349. Little Green (Gray) Sunbird Anthreptes seimundi

A single bird on Feb 25 (Busingiro, BNP).

#### 350. Collared Sunbird Hedydipna collaris

Common, seen seen on 7 days during the tour. First seen on Feb 26 (BNP).

#### 351. Green-headed Sunbird Cyanomitra verticalis

Nice views of a male along the School Track (Ruhija, Mar 2) and Buhoma (female, Mar 4).

#### 352. Blue-throated Brown Sunbird Cyanomitra cyanolaema

Seen in BNP (Busingiro, Feb 25), KNP (Feb 28) and Bwindi (Mar 4).

#### 353. Western Olive Sunbird Cyanometra obscura

Two birds at Busingiro (Feb 25. BNP) and Buhoma (Mar 4).

#### 354. Green-throated Sunbird Chalcomitra rubescens

Three birds at Buhoma (BINP, Mar 4).

#### 355. Scarlet-chested Sunbird Chalcomitra senegalensis

Seen on 5 days, 1-2 birds/day, e.g. 2 birds at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 356. Bronze Sunbird Nectarinia kilimensis

Good views of this spectacular Sunbird. Seen on 5 days, first seen (male and female) at Ikoba (Feb 27).

# 357. Olive-bellied Sunbird Cinnyris chloropygius

See on 6 days, first seen at BNP (Feb 25).

# 358. Regal Sunbird Cinnyris regius

A stunning bird, one of the Albertine Rift endemics, seen on Mar 2-4 near Ruhija (School Track and Mubwindi Swamp Track).

# 359. Mariqua Sunbird Cinnyris mariquensis suahelicus

Two birds in the fruiting tree at the "garage" (Mbarara) during the afternoon car break down (Mar 6).

### 360. Red-chested Sunbird Cinnyris erythrocercus

Seen on 5 days, most common at QENP, 30+ birds on Feb 29 and 20 birds on Mar 1.

#### 361. Orange-tufted Sunbird Cinnyris bouvieri

A single bird on Mar 1 (QENP).

# 362. Superb Sunbird Cinnyris superbus

This large Sunbird seen at BNP (Feb 25) and KNP (Feb 28).

#### 363. Variable Sunbird Cinnyris venustus igneiventris

One male along the approach road to Ruhija (Mar 4).

# 364. Copper Sunbird Cinnyris cupreus

A single bird at Kiboga (Feb 23).

#### **ZOSTEROPIDAE**

#### 365. African Yellow White-eye Zosterops senegalensis stuhlmanni

Common from Feb 28 (Chimps' Nest, KNP) onwards. Seen on 5 days.

# ORIOLIDAE

#### 366. African Golden Oriole Oriolus auratus

A single bird while travelling to KNP (Feb 27).

# 367. **Western Black-headed Oriole** *Oriolus brachyrhynchus* Rather common at BNP (Feb 26-27) and heard at KNP (Feb 28).


# 368. **African Black-headed Oriole** *Oriolus larvatus*A single bird along the entrance road to Lake Mburo NP (Mar 6).

# 369. **Black-tailed Oriole** *Oriolus percivali* Seen at Ruhija and Buhoma (Mar 2-5).

# 370. **Woodchat Shrike** *Lanius senator* Two birds at MFNP (Feb 24).

# 371. **Gray-backed Fiscal** *Lanius excubitoroides*Common during the tour, e.g. 5 birds at MFNP (Feb 24).



# 372. **Mackinnon's Shrike** *Lanius mackinnoni* Three birds near Ruhija (School Track, Mar 2).

# 373. **Common Fiscal** *Lanius collaris*Common throughout the tour, e.g. 6 birds at QENP (Feb 29).

# MALACONOTIDAE

# 374. **Northern Puffback** *Dryoscopus gambensis* Seen near Ruhija (Mar 2 and 3).

# 375. **Marsh Tchagra** *Tchagra minutes*Nice views of a single bird near the Chimps' Nest (KNP, Feb 28). Also a single bird on Mar 2.

# 376. **Black-crowned Tchagra** *Tchagra senegalus* A single bird at KNP (Feb 28), also seen on 2 other days.

# 377. **Brown-crowned Tchagra** *Tchagra australis* Seen on Feb 25 (MFNP), also singles at BINP (Mar 5 and 6).

# 378. **Luehder's Bushshrike** *Laniarius luehderi* Seen daily (1-2 birds/day) at Ruhija and Buhoma (Mar 2-5).

### 379. Tropical Boubou Laniarius aethiopicus

A single bird at QENP (Mar 1).

#### 380. Black-headed Gonolek Laniarius erythrogaster

Good views of this bird on several days, e.g. 3 birds at MFNP (Feb 24). Common at QENP.

#### 381. Papyrus Gonolek Laniarius mufumbiri

Beautiful views of this very colourful bird at a papyrus swamp (at Rwankore) on Feb 27 (drive to KNP).

#### 382. Mountain Sooty Boubou Laniarius poensis

A single bird heard along the Mubwindi Swamp Track near Ruhija (BINP).

# 383. Gray-green (Bocage's) Bushshrike Telophorus bocagei

Single birds on Feb 28 (Chimps' Nest, KNP) and Mar 5 (Buhoma).

#### **DICRURIDAE**

### 384. Fork-tailed Drongo Dicrurus adsimilis

Seen on at least 4 days, e.g. 2 birds when travelling to MFNP (Feb 23). Most common at QENP (6 birds at Mar 2).

#### **CORVIDAE**

#### 385. Piapiac Ptilostomus afer

Common while travelling to MFNP (Feb 23) and common (about 30 birds) at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 386. Pied Crow Corvus albus

Common, seen in several villages and towns, e.g. 2 birds on Feb 23.

#### **STURNIDAE**

#### 387. Lesser Blue-eared Glossy-Starling Lamprotornis chloropterus

Seen on 3 days, e.g. 2 birds at Bugungu Wildlife Reserve while travelling to MFNP (Feb 23).

### 388. Splendid Glossy-Starling Lamprotornis splendidus

Seen on 4 days. Highest count 10 birds at KNP (Chimps' Nest, Feb 28).

#### 389. Rueppell's Glossy-Starling Lamprotornis purpuroptera

By far the most common Starling seen, e.g. 10+ birds on several days, including MFNP (Feb 24).

# 390. Purple-headed Glossy-Starling Lamprotornis purpureiceps

Three birds at KNP (Feb 27) and 5 birds at Nyabubara (Chimps' Nest, Feb 28; KNP).

# 391. Violet-backed Starling Cinnyricinclus leucogaster

Seen on 4 days, e.g. 5 birds at KNP (Feb 28).

# 392. Slender-billed Starling Onychognathus tenuirostris

About 14 birds near Ruhija (School Track, Mar 3).

#### 393. Waller's Starling Onychognathus walleri

A single bird near the Neck (Kitahurira) at BINP (Mar 4).

# 394. Narrow-tailed Starling Poeoptera lugubris

Six birds at KNP (Feb 28).

#### 395. Sharpe's Starling Pholia sharpii

Seen near Ruhija (School Track, Mar 2).

### 396. Yellow-billed Oxpecker Buphagus africanus

Seen on 3 days, e.g. 6 birds at MFNP (Feb 25).

#### **PASSERIDAE**

### 397. Gray-headed Sparrow Passer griseus

Common, seen on most days of the tour, associated with towns and villages. Four birds while travelling to MFNP (Feb 23).

#### 398. House Sparrow Passer domesticus

A female at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 399. (Shelley's ) Rufous Sparrow Passer rufocinctus (shelleyi)

Three birds seen during the game drive at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### **PLOCEIDAE**

#### 400. Baglafecht Weaver Ploceus baglafecht stuhlmanni

Singles at BNP (Nyabyeya, Feb 26), Ruija (School Track, Mar 2) and Mar 6.

#### 401. Slender-billed Weaver Ploceus pelzelni

Common at QENP (Feb 29-Mar 1) and also seen at Mar 6 and 7.

#### 402. Little Weaver Ploceus luteolus

A single male at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 403. Lesser Masked-Weaver Ploceus intermedius

Singles at Mar 6 (Nshara Gate road to Lake Mburo NP) and 7 (IBG, Entebbe).

#### 404. Spectacled Weaver Ploceus ocularis

Three birds at Rougongo (Feb 28).

## 405. Black-necked Weaver Ploceus nigricollis

Seen at Ikoba and Chimps' Nest (KNP; Feb 27 and 28) and Buhoma (Mar 4-5).

#### 406. Black-billed Weaver Ploceus melanogaster

Singles near Ruhija (School Track, Mar 2-3).

# 407. Holub's Golden-Weaver Ploceus xanthops

Seen near Chimps' Nest (KNP, Feb 27-28).

#### 408. Northern Brown-throated Weaver Ploceus castanops

Seen at Mar 6 (Kinoni) and 7 (IBG).

# 409. Village Weaver Ploceus cucullatus

Common on Feb 23 (Kiboga) while travelling to MFNP and in MFNP (Feb 25).

#### 410. Vieillot's Weaver Ploceus nigerrimus

Seen in good numbers (10-60 birds/day), most common at BNP (Feb 26).

# 411. Yellow-backed (Black-headed) Weaver Ploceus melanocephalus

Seen on 5 days, highest day counts (50-100) at QENP (Feb 29 – Mar 1).

#### 412. Golden-backed Weaver Ploceus jacksoni

About 10 birds at the shore of Lake Albert (IBG, Mar 7).

# 413. Brown-capped Weaver Ploceus insignis

A colourful forest Weaver with a Woodpecker-like behaviour. Four birds seen along Mubwindi Swamp Track (Mar 3).

# 414. Orange Weaver Ploceus aurantius

At least 4 birds at the IBG (Mar 7).

# 415. Compact Weaver Pachyphantes superciliosus

Five birds at Ikoba Swamp while driving to KNP (Feb 27).

#### 416. Red-headed Malimbe Malimbus rubricollis

Two birds at KNP (Sebitoli, Feb 27) and a single bird at Mar 4 (BINP).

# 417. Red-headed Weaver Anaplectes rubriceps

Nice views of a single nesting bird at MFNP (Feb 25).

#### 418. Red-headed Quelea Quelea erythrops

Two birds at Nyabubara (Chimps' Nest) at KNP (Feb 28).

#### 419. Black-winged Red Bishop Euplectes hordeaceus

Five birds in some rural fields near the Royal Mile ((BNP, Feb 26).

#### 420. Red Bishop Euplectes orix

Ten birds at Mweya (QENP, Mar 1).

#### 421. Fan-tailed Widowbird Euplectes axillaries

Two birds seen at a small papyrus swamp (Rwabigangura, Mar 6). About 10 birds at MS (Mar 7).

#### 422. Grosbeak Weaver Amblyospiza albifrons

About 50 birds at Nyabubara (Chimps' Nest, KNP; Feb 28).

# 423. Speckle-fronted Weaver Sporopipes frontalis

At least 10+ birds at MFNP (Feb 24).

### **ESTRILDIDAE**

# 424. Woodhouse's Antpecker Parmoptila woodhousei

Captured in a mist net at Bwindi, a female was seen in hand and after release. Being a rare bird and out of range, it was still a very nice bird to see (BINP, Mar 5).



# 425. White-breasted Negrofinch Nigrita fusconotus

Heard on Feb 25 (Budongo) and seen (3 birds) at Feb 26 (Royal Mile, BNP). A single bird at Feb 28 (KNP).

### 426. Gray-headed Negrofinch Nigrita canicapillus

Two birds while travelling to KNP (Ikoba, Feb 27) and a single bird at Bwindi (BINP, Mar 4).

#### 427. Grey-headed Oliveback Nesocharis capistrata

Very good views of a single bird at Rwankore while travelling to KNP (Feb 27).

#### 428. Green-winged Pytilia Pytilia melba

Two birds at QENP (Mar 1).

#### 429. Green-backed Twinspot Mandingoa nitidula

Heard on Feb 26 (Royal Mile, BNP).

#### 430. Brown Twinspot Clytospiza monteiri

Briefly seen (3 birds) at Nyabyeya near KNP (Feb 26).

#### 431. Red-billed Firefinch Lagonosticta senegala

Seen (20+) at QENP (Mar 1). The birds seen had a black bill.

#### 432. Black-bellied Firefinch Lagonosticta rara

A male and female at our banda at Masindi (Feb 27).

# 433. Red-cheeked Cordonbleu Uraeginthus bengalus

Seen at various day, e.g. 10 birds at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 434. Yellow-bellied Waxbill Estrilda quartinia

Three birds near Ruhija (School Track, Mar 3).

# 435. Fawn-breasted Waxbill Estrilda paludicola

A small flock (10+ birds) at MFNP (Feb 24).

#### 436. Common Waxbill Estrilda astrild

Four birds near KNP (Feb 27) and another 4 birds at Mar 7.

## 437. Black-crowned Waxbill Estrilda nonnula

A single bird while travelling to MFNP (Kiboga, Feb 23) and 2 birds at Mar 4 (Buhoma).

#### 438. Bronze Mannikin Spermestes cucullatus

Common, seen on most days, e.g. 8 birds at QENP (Mar 1).

# 439. Black-and-white Mannikin Spermestes bicolor

Seen on 5 days (3-10 birds/day), first seen at the Royal Mile (KNP, Feb 26).

#### **VIDUIDAE**

#### 440. Village Indigobird Vidua chalybeate

About 50 birds at Kihihi when travelling to Entebbe (Mar 6).

# 441. Pin-tailed Whydah Vidua macroura

Common at QENP, 10-50+ birds/day, from Feb 29-Mar 2.

#### 442. Western Citril Serinus frontalis

A single bird at Ikoba Swamp when travelling to KNP (Feb 27).

# 443. Yellow-fronted Canary Serinus mozambicus

Common, seen on 6 days, first bird at BNP (Feb 26).

A single bird along the School Track (Ruhija, Mar 3).

#### 445. Thick-billed Seedeater Serinus burtoni

Two birds at the Mubwindi Swamp Track near Ruhija (Mar 4).

#### **MAMMALS**

Olive Baboon Paio anubis
 Common at MFNP, KNP and Bwindi.





- 2. **Gray-cheeked Mangabey** *Lophocebus albigenea* Two seen at KNP (Feb 28).
- 3. **Vervet Monkey** *Cercopithecus pygerythrus* Common at MFNP, QENP and at the IBG.
- 4. **Gentle (Blue) Monkey** *Cercopithecus mitis* Seen at Feb 25 (MFNP) and 27.
- 5. **L'Hoest Monkey** *Cercopithecus Ihoesti* Seen at BNP (Feb 26) and Bwindi.
- 6. **Red-tailed Monkey** *Cercopithecus ascanius* Seen at both BNP and KNP.
- 7. **Patas Monkey** *Erythrocebus patas*This striking Monkey seen during the Nile tour at MFNP (Feb 24).
- 8. **Red Colobus** *Piliocolobus oustaleti* Seen at KNP (Feb27).
- 9. **Guereza** (Black and White) Colobus Colobus guereza Common at BNP. Also seen at QENP and IBG.
- 10. **Chimpanzee** *Pan troglodytes*Heard on Feb 28 (KNP). Stunning (close) views of 20-40 animals on Feb 29.
- 11. **Mountain Gorilla** *Gorilla gorilla*Heard on Mar 3. Two animals seen at Bwindi, an animal –probably a female- at close range and an immature trying to climb into a small tree (Mar 5).
- Burchell's Zebra Equus burchelli
   Three animals along the entrance road to Lake Mburo NP (mar 6).
- 13. **Common Warthog** *Phacochoerus africanus* Common at MFNP and QENP.
- 14. **Hippopotamus** *Hippopotamus amphibious* Common along the Nile, estimated 200+ on Feb 24 (MFNP). Also common at QENP.



- 15. **Rothschildt's Giraffe** *Giraffa* (*camelop.*) *rothschildi*About 20 animals, including a female plus immature, North of the Nile at MFNP (Feb 24).
- African Buffalo Syncerus caffer
   Common at both MFNP and QENP. Some animals at QENP were brown and not black.
- 17. **Topi** *Damaliscus lunatus* About 15 animals at QENP (Mar 2).
- 18. **Bushbuck** *Tragelaphus scriptus*Seen at MFNP (5 animals, Feb 24). Also seen on 2 other days, including a single animals along the entrance road to QENP.
- 19. **Defassa Waterbuck** *Kobus elipsiprymnus defassa* Seen along the Nile (Feb 24, MFNP) and common at QENP (Feb 29 Mar 2).
- 20. **Uganda Kob** *Kobus kob* Seen at MFNP. Most common at QENP, estimated 1000+ at Mar 1.

# 21. **Jackson's Hartebeest (Kongoni)** *Alcelaphus jacksoni* At least 10+ animals during the boat tour at MFNP (Feb 24).

# 22. **Impala** *Aepycerus melampus* About 25 along the entrance road to Lake Mburo NP (mar 6).

# 23. **Oribi** *Ourebia ourebi* Common (50+) during the game drive at MFNP (Feb 24).

# 24. **Black-fronted Duiker** *Cephalophus nigrifrons*Nicely seen when crossing the trail to Mubwindi Swamp (BINP, Mar 3).

# 25. **African Elephant** *Loxodonta africana* Common during the game drive and boat tour at MFNP (Feb 24).

# 26. **Banded Mongoose** *Mungos mungos* About 20 in QENP (Mar 1).

# 27. **Leopard** *Panthera pardus* Incredible views of a Leopard preening along the road at QENP (Mar 2).



#### 28. Lion Panthera leo

Two sleeping females at QENP (Mar 1). When leaving QENP (Mar 2), one of the famous tree-climbing Lions seen, sleeping in tree.

- 29. **Red-legged Sun Squirrel** *Heliosciurus rufobrachium* Two seen at KNP (feb 28). Also a single animal seen near Ruhija (Mar 3).
- 30. **Striped Ground Squirrel** *Euxerus erythopus* A single animal at the IBG (Mar 7).
- 31. **Carruther's Mountain Squirrel** *Funisciurus carruthersi* Two seen near Ruhija (BINP, Mar 3).
- 32. **Alexander's Dwarf Squirrel** *Paraxerus alexandri* Two seen at KNP (Feb 27).

#### **REPTILES**

- Nile Crocodile Crocodylus niloticus
   About 20 seen during the boat tour at MFNP (Feb 24).
- 2. **Blue-headed Tree Agama** Acanthocerus atricollis Two seen near the lodge at Mweya (QENP, Mar 1).





- 3. **Red-headed Rock Agama** *Agama agama* Two seen near the Nile (Feb 24).
- 4. **Tropical House Gecko** *Hemidactylus mabouia* Seen on several days.

# **MISCELLANEOUS**

Variety of Butterflies at KNP, tiny black Snake sp. Near Ruhija (BINP, Mar 3) and a small Snake, addertype, near Ruhija (BINP, Mar 2). Also a very large worm, > 1 foot, should be mentioned!
